

# CITY OF WARREN POOL RULES FOR THE PUBLIC

## ENFORCEMENT OF POOL REGULATIONS IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF LIFEGUARDS AND/OR POOL SUPERVISORS

1. **Anyone under 7 years of age must be accompanied by a paying adult 18 years or older. This person must be in the water with the child under 7 showing an interest in their well being.**
2. NO person suffering from any contagious disease or infectious condition shall be allowed to enter the pool. This includes but not limited to skin lesions, sore or inflamed eyes, and nose or ear discharge.
3. **ADDITIONAL PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES**
  - No DIVING in the pool at any time
  - No running or horseplay
  - No balls, diving sticks, or other toys are permitted in the pool
  - No profanity
  - No food in or around the pool or pool deck
  - No SMOKING anywhere inside the pool complex (including vapor products)
  - No contests involving holding your breath under water
  - No snorkels or any other type of goggles that cover the nose
4. In case of an emergency, notify the nearest lifeguard
5. At the sound of the lifeguards' whistles or horns, all swimmers **MUST** exit the pool **IMMEDIATELY** at the nearest ladder. Lifeguard will blow whistle 15 minutes before closing time.
6. In case of thunder or lightning, pools must be cleared immediately. Patrons can report to any shelter that is not made of metal. Patrons may return to the pool 20 minutes after the last thunder or 30 minutes after the last lightning sighting when instructed by the lifeguard.
7. Non-swimmers must stay in shallow water not above their shoulders. You may be asked to perform a swimming test.
8. Bubbles and integrated PFD's from the YMCA are the only personal flotation devices permitted.
9. Patrons must be dressed in appropriate swimming attire (swim suits). No cut-off jeans or colored T-shirts are permitted. Only white T-shirts are permitted.
10. The City of Warren is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
11. Patrons 18 years or older are permitted to use the pool during adult swim, which occurs for 15 minutes every hour at fifteen of the hour. Children under 7 may be in the kid pool only **with** a paying adult over 18.
12. The slide will be closed during adult swim.
13. If a person of any age cannot perform a swim test, they cannot use the slide.
14. Under NO circumstances may a person catch a person who is using the slide.
15. No spitting or urinating in the pool.
16. No glass or sharp objects in or around pool, pool deck or restrooms.
17. Do not use pool if you have had diarrhea in the last 2 weeks.
