Residents of the City of Warren are hereby informed that the City expects to submit an application in October 2020 to the PA Dept. of Community and Economic Development under its Small Communities Program (SCP) for \$306,049 in FFY 2020 entitlement funds.

The City of Warren proposes utilization of FFY 2020 funds for the administration and construction of street/road improvements to South Irvine Street. Intended improvements include pavement, sub-base, curbing, sidewalk, drainage, and sewer improvements.

The City of Warren also proposes that FFY 2020 funds be utilized under the Slums/Blighted-Area-Boundary National Objective Definition to address blight conditions within the City of Warren's designated downtown redevelopment area. Funding will specifically address the redevelopment area's public/community facility needs.

All interested citizens are encouraged to attend and will be offered the opportunity to give oral testimony at the Public Hearing and/or to present written comments concerning the needs of the City of Warren, proposed CDBG Program activities, the prior use of CDBG funds, as well as the CDBG Program in general.
