

DeFrees Park

DeFrees Park is located on Fourth Avenue between Hickory and Liberty Streets. The gazebo-style pavilion, constructed in 2001, provides picnic seating for approximately 50 persons. Additional facilities include restrooms, fitness course, playground equipment, basketball hoop, and limited off street parking.



Lacy Park

Located at the corner of Madison Avenue and Marion Street, this 3-acre site offers a pavilion, play equipment, basketball court, and ball field, and is a site for the Summer Playground Program. The pavilion offers space for 3 tables to accommodate about 30 people. Look for some exciting changes in 2021 which will include upgrades and a Sensory Playground.



Beaty Park

This 6-acre park is located at the corner of Fifth and Conewango Avenues. This is a truly active park with assets including a pavilion, ball field with bleachers, 3 tennis courts with coin-operated lights, basketball court with lights, skate park with coin-operated lights, pickle ball court, tetherball, playground equipment including ADA-approved apparatus, and an ADA-accessible limestone pathway connecting the amenities. The park is popular for sled riding and is also a site for the Summer Playground Program.



Pavilion Reservation

Weekday reservations entitle the requestor to utilize the pavilion for the full day, 8:00 AM - 9:00 PM.

Reservations (Friday, Saturday or Sunday) may be for a full day or half day. Half day reservations may be made for 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM or 3:00 PM - 9:00 PM (there are no exceptions to these hours).

Restroom facilities are available at all locations. A key may be obtained at the tax office in the Municipal Building on the business day prior to the scheduled event.






Park Activities

The City of Warren offers a supervised walk-in **Summer Playground Program** that is open to all children aged 7 to 14 years of age operating at Crescent, Lacy and Beatty Parks. Throughout the summer, children will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of sports, arts and crafts, and educational activities. All children wishing to participate in any of the activities must be registered at one of the participating playgrounds. WALKABLE WARREN

Promoting healthy lifestyle, a trail connects existing bike/walk paths to the City's Downtown through existing streets from the trail at the end of East St. west to Betts Park or east to the Glade Bridge.



Park Facilities

The City of Warren offers a variety of picnic pavilions in four parks throughout the City that may be rented for family activities and special events with off-street parking and restrooms available at most.

Clifford R. Betts Park

More commonly known as Betts Park, this park is located just off Route 6 on Ludlow Street. At fifty acres, Betts Park is the largest of the City's active parks with assets including three softball fields, Little League field, 2 bocce courts, 3 tennis courts, basketball courts, 2 playgrounds, a boat launch, and 4 pavilions. For those wishing to enjoy the park at a more leisurely pace, a walking trail follows the park perimeter and offers tranquil views of the Allegheny River.

The Joseph H. DeFrees Pavilion is located at the eastern end of Betts Park. Approximately 15 tables provide a seating capacity of 140. Charcoal grills, electricity, and water are available. Playground equipment is located nearby.



The Betts Pavilion is located at the western end of Betts Park. Approximately 14 tables provide a seating capacity of 130. Charcoal grills, electricity, and water are available. Playground equipment is located nearby.



The Riverwalk Pavilion is located at the eastern end of Betts Park. Approximately 10 tables provide a seating capacity of 80. Charcoal grills, electricity, and water are available. Playground equipment is located nearby.



The Bocce Pavilion & Courts are located at the western end of the Park. Approximately 8 tables provide a seating capacity of 48. Charcoal grills, water and electricity are available. Pavilion reservation includes use of the adjoining bocce courts, however, you must provide the equipment.



Crescent Park

Crescent Park is located on the southern bank of the Allegheny River. A crushed limestone walkway winds through the park and provides a scenic view of the Allegheny River for walkers and joggers alike. The western portion of the park is home to a basketball court, ADA accessible playground, restrooms, pavilion, and riverside picnic tables with charcoal grills. The Summer Playground Program operates at this site.

Crescent Park Pavilion has approximately 10 tables providing a seating capacity of 80. Charcoal grills, electricity, and water are available. Playground equipment is located nearby.
