

**WARREN CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL MEETING

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**OPENING OF MEETING**

Mr. Wortman, Council Vice-President presided over the June 7, 2021, special meeting of Warren City Council in Council Chambers of the Municipal Building and opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**ROLL CALL**

Members present and responding to roll call were: Mayor Maurice Cashman (via Zoom), Gregory Fraser (via Zoom), Paul Giannini (via Zoom), Philip Gilbert, Douglas Hearn, and John Wortman. Members of City Staff present were Nancy Freenock, City Manager (via Zoom); Teena Leary, Assistant City Clerk; and Chad Yurisc, City Engineer.

**SOUTH SOUTH STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT BID AWARD**

Mr. Yurisc stated that a bid opening was held on Wednesday, June 2, 2021, for the South South Street Improvement Project. The project is to be funded with 2017, 2018, and 2019 FFY Community Development Block Grant funds. Three (3) bids were received with the apparent low bidder being Lake Shore Paving, Inc. from Jamestown, NY. Mr. Yurisc stated that there were no irregularities noted with the bid and Greenman-Pedersen, Inc., City Engineering firm, has worked with Lake Shore Paving, Inc. in the past; therefore, they are also the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The base bid amount is \$457,750.00 and came in under the \$591,249.31 CDBG total grant amount available.

Upon motion by Mr. Fraser and second by Mr. Gilbert, the six seated Council members voted unanimously to award the South South Street Improvement Project contract to Lake Shore Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$457,750.00.

Mr. Yurisc stated that work on the project is expected to commence in early July, 2021.
