These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the City of Warren.

**Request for Release of Funds**

On or about November 16, 2018, the City of Warren will submit a request to the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) for the release of Community Development Block Grant funds to undertake a project known as Park Avenue Improvement Project for the purpose of reconstruction of street infrastructure including surfacing, drainage, curbing/gutter, sidewalk and retaining wall on Park Avenue. The estimated cost is \$340,000 from CDBG Multi-Year.

**Finding of No Significant Impact**

The City of Warren has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at the City of Warren Municipal Building, 318 West Third Avenue, Warren, PA. It may be examined or copied weekdays, 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM. Persons interested in examining the record should contact David L. Hildebrand, Planner/Development Administrator.

**Public Comments**

Any individual, group, or agency disagreeing with this determination or wishing to comment on the project may submit written comments to the City of Warren, 318 West Third Avenue, Warren, PA 16365. All comments received by November 16, 2018, will be considered by the City of Warren prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

**Release of Funds**

The City of Warren certifies to DCED that Maurice Cashman in his capacity as Mayor consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. DCED's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities, and allows the City of Warren to use Program funds.

**Objections to Release of Funds**

DCED will accept objections to release of funds and the City of Warren's certification for a period of 15 days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the City of Warren; (b) the City of Warren has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient has committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by DCED; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to Department of Community and Economic Development, Center for Community Building, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor Commonwealth Keystone Building, Harrisburg, PA 17120-0225. Potential objectors should contact DCED to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
